The P.G. Department of Linguistics established in the year 1983 in Berhampur University has been a centre for the study and research of indigenous and lesser known languages belonging to the Dravidian, Munda, and Indo-Aryan families spoken in South Odisha. It is the only department of its kind in the state of Odisha that offers a wide range of programmes on the campus such as MA, and PhD in Linguistics and Diploma in the Russian Language. At present, the Department's research focus is on documenting, preparing grammars, dictionaries and pedagogical materials on these languages.

Central Institute of Indian Languages (CIIL) is the premier research and teaching institute established by the Govt. of India in 1969. The main aim of the Institute is to study, develop and support Indian languages in every domain.

The motto of the ELKL conferences has been to encourage young researchers to work on lesser known languages and train them in language documentation and revitalization.
