- Correlation and Regression analysis
- Analysis of Variance (ANOVA): One-way and two way
- Multivariate Analysis: Data reduction and data classification tools
- Logit and Probit Analysis
- Factor Analysis and Principal Component Analysis
- Understanding Volatility Models: AR, MA, ARIMA, ARCH & GARCH model
- Application of ARDL and NARDL
