About the Conference 2.0

Relooking at Indian history requires re-evaluating the content and context of the historical methods and narratives. Colonial theories of historical writings must be examined for their reliability and necessity. It's not like Indian history written during the colonial period became unimportant. It's the society for which history must be proved positive and worthy. History should preach peace and harmony. Following the scientific method alone may not be sufficient to establish the truth of historical events. People believe, and oral narratives have also played an important role in the process. However, historians have not fully adopted these methods in the process of reconstructing Indian history. It's time to re-look at Indian history and its methodologies, which are fixed for historical writings and studies.

The objective of the seminar is to invite academicians and experts to debate this subject. Creating a platform to relook at Indian history for rational and judicious history writing and to establish an equal and egalitarian society.

About the Department of History:

The Department was established in 1968. Prof. K. C. Panigrahi (Padmasri) was the first head of the department. The department offers a two-year Master's degree course in History with specializations in Ancient Indian History, Medieval Indian history, and Modern Indian History. The department is offering PhD and D. Litt. programs. The Department has a Library and Archival Cell that contains a large number of gazetteers, Reports, Proceedings, Journals, Private papers, and Rare Books relating to history and culture. In recognition of the academic achievements of the department, the UGC has sanctioned the Special Assistance Programme (at DRS level) for the department. The UGC has also sanctioned the ASIHSS programme in addition to SAP for its achievements in the first phase of SAP for a period of five years. Besides these, the department has been publishing a bi-annual research journal entitled Studies in History and Culture (ISSN: 0971-9326) of international standard since 1993. In 2018, the department completed 50 years and celebrated its Golden Jubilee year.
