At the outset the Vice-Chancellor stressed on the following points for the better management of the University affairs:

- (1) There should be proper training of all the staff members of the University. Special training should be given to the staff posted in the Finance Section. Concerned Departments of the Government be moved for imparting training to the staff of the University in phased manner. This should be given priority for systematic and quick disposal of files.
- (2) The Vice-Chancellor commented that the Resolutions taken by the Syndicate should be confirmed in the very next meeting, instead of placing resolutions of four meetings at a time. The Registrar informed that it is the usual practice to confirm the proceedings in the very next meeting, but this time owing to urgency, two Emergency Meetings were convened at a very short notice on 27.06.2019 and


12.10.19.

05.08.2019 and the Action Taken Report could not be obtained. However, in future care will be taken to confirm the resolutions in the very next meeting of the Syndicate.

- (3) It is observed that many items are brought to the Syndicate for ratification, i.e. after execution of the projects or after making expenditure on a particular item after obtaining A/A from the Vice-Chancellor. Hence, extreme care should be taken before according Administrative Approval and should be routed through the relevant Committees before according such approval as per statutory requirement. Further, the Syndicate should be informed well in advance about the expenditure.
- (4) The Controller of Examinations is required to prepare an Action Plan for conduct of examinations, evaluation of answer scripts and timely publication of results in the interest of the students. The meetings of the Boards of Studies should be convened in time for preparation of panel of examiners/evaluators/question setters.

Acd-II (S&S) Section:

Accordingly, Office Order be issued immediately.


Examination Gen. (UG) Section:

175. Considered the Report of Syndicate Sub-Committee (constituted vide Syndicate Resolution No. 43 dated 23.2.2019), which recommended the criteria for fixation of centres for conduct of +3 TDC Examinations in the forthcoming years.

Resolved that: After detailed discussion on the Report of the Sub-Committee, it is decided that the selection of Examination Centres should be streamlined properly and kept sacrosanct and the list of such Examination Centres for each subject be set well in advance.

The request for allotment of Examination Centre for the affiliated Colleges (presently not declared as Examination Centre) should be submitted before 31st July of every year and no request submitted after the due date will be entertained. A Local Enquiry be conducted to observe all the nitty-gritty like: infrastructure, brick boundary wall, drinking water, adequate classrooms with proper size, electrification, faculty strength, separate toilets for boys' and girls', PWD friendly infrastructure (ramps, special toilets, etc.), examinees and invigilator ratio, CCTV Camera, etc. prior to allotment of Examination Centre. In case of any deficiency on the above aspects, Examination Centre will not be allotted. The Local Enquiry Committee shall consist of:

- (a) Chairman/Chairperson, P.G. Council
- (b) One Syndicate Member to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor
- (c) Registrar

The same was placed before the Syndicate in its meeting held on 27.7.2017 and the Syndicate vide Resolution No. 311 resolved that:

"The recommendations of the Committee be sent to the Government in the Department of Higher Education, Odisha for necessary approval/clearance. However, those teachers who intends to submit any document/evidences pertaining to their redesignation may submit the same by 5th September 2017".

- Pursuant to the Syndicate Resolution No. 311 dated 27.7.2017, a Circular has been issued stating that the Lecturers who intends to submit any document/evidences pertaining to their re-designation may submit the same by 5th September 2017.
- Accordingly, 12 Lecturers have submitted relevant papers/documents and the Screening-cum-Evaluation Committee again met on 11.12.2017 and 14.12.2017 and recommended for re-designation of 11 Lecturers as Assistant Professor Stage-1 taking into consideration the Certificate duly signed by the competent authority in connection with fulfilling the five conditions as stipulated in the UGC Regulations, 2016 in its 4th Amendment dated 11 July 2016. Later, the case of Dr. Bonomali Khuntia was recommended by the same Committee on 1.1.2018.

The UGC Regulations, 2016 in its 4th Amendment stipulates that:

Provided further, the award of degree to candidates registered for the M.Phil./Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bylaws/Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and the Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/ Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- a) Ph.D. degree of the candidate awarded in regular mode only;
- b) Evaluation of the Ph.D. thesis by at least two external examiners;
- c) Open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate had been conducted;
- d) Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work out of which at least one must be in a refereed journal;
- e) Candidate has made at least two presentations in conferences/seminars, based on his/her Ph.D. work.

(a) to (e) as above are to be certified by the Vice-Chancellor/Pro-Vice-Chancellor/Dean (Academic Affairs)/Dean (University instructions)."

In UGC Regulations, 2010, clearing NET/SLET/SET was compulsory.

5. The Syndicate in its meeting held on 27.01.2018 considered the Proceedings of the Screening-cum-Evaluation Committee Meeting held on 11.12.2017, 15.12.2017 and 1.1.2018 and vide Resolution No. 14&15 resolved that "This be approved and Office Order be issued subject to approval of Government in the Department of Higher Education, Odisha". Accordingly, the University vide Letter No. 1308/Adm-I (TE) dated 23.2.2018 requested to convey the approval of the Government in the matter of re-designation of Lecturers as Assistant Professor (Stage-1) and further sought clarification whether the Lecturers will be re-designated as Assistant Professor (Stage-1) w.e.f. their date of joining in the post or from the date of Government Resolution. In the said letter, the University has submitted the copies of the Syndicate Resolution Nos. 14&15 dated 27.1.2018 along with the Proceedings of the Screening-cum-Evaluation Committee Meeting dated 11.12.2017, 15.12.2017 and 1.1.2018.
6. In response to the said letter, the Department of Higher Education vide Letter No. 11262/HE dated 31.5.2019 conveyed the approval for re-designation of 36 nos. of Lecturers of Berhampur University as Assistant Professor (Stage-1) from the date of issue of the Resolution No. 7889/HE dated 4.4.2016 of the Department of Higher Education, Odisha. In the said letter, it is also mentioned that the services rendered by them as Lecturers shall be counted for consideration of their promotion to the next higher grade under CAS.
7. The Syndicate in its meeting held on 27.6.2019 considered re-designation of 36 nos. of Lecturers of Berhampur University as Assistant Professor (Stage-1) from the date of issue of the Resolution No. 7889/HE dated 4.4.2016 of the Department of Higher Education, Odisha i.e. 04.04.2016 as per the clarification/approval received from the Government in the Department of Higher Education vide Letter No. 11262/HE dated 31.5.2019.

The Syndicate vide Resolution No. 169/27.6.2019 Resolved that:

"In the first phase, the 24 Lecturers who are fulfilling the minimum eligibility standard as per UGC Regulations, 2010 and 2013 be re-designated as Assistant Professor (Stage-1).

Further resolved that the case of the remaining 12 Lecturers be referred again to the Government in the Department of Higher Education, Odisha furnishing all the details with a request to consider their cases for re-designation as Assistant Professor (Stage-1)."



8. However, in view of the joint letter dated 5.7.2019 submitted by three Members of the Syndicate who were present in the Syndicate Meeting held on 27.6.2019, the matter was again referred to the Syndicate meeting held on 13.09.2019 (i.e. before confirmation of the Minutes of the Syndicate Meeting held on 27.6.2019) to reconsider re-designation of 36 nos. of Lecturers of Berhampur University as Assistant Professor (Stage-1) from the date of issue of the Resolution No. 7889/HE dated 4.4.2016 of the Department of Higher Education, Odisha i.e. 04.04.2016 and counting of the services rendered by them as Lecturers for consideration of their promotion to the next higher grade under CAS as per the clarification/approval received from the Government in the Department of Higher Education vide Letter No. 11262/HE dated 31.5.2019.



AFFILIATION MATTER OF GANJAM LAW COLLEGE, BERHAMPUR

As per Statute 173 (2) of OUPS, 1990, for opening a new college, the college is required to submit copy of the Government Order in the appropriate department granting concurrence to the proposal for opening of the college along with a copy of permission from the concerned All-India body or the Council, as the case may be (wherever such permission is necessary). Further, as per Statute 173 (1), copy of the Government order in appropriate department granting recognition to the college is to be submitted.

However, as per the Bar Council of India Rules (Part-IV, Chapter III) Clause 16 (2), "After affiliation order is received from the University, the Centres of Legal Education may only then apply for inspection by the Bar Council of India".

As per the Bar Council of India Rules (Part-IV, Chapter III) Clause 16 (1), the University has to ensure that the college fulfils certain conditions. It may be mentioned here that the same conditions are laid down in the University Statutes under Statute 171-182 and the Local Enquiry Committee verifies the same physically during inspection and submits its report.

After grant of affiliation, the college is required to apply to the Bar Council of India depositing the requisite fee for consideration of "approval of affiliation". The Bar Council of India in its turn, instruct to refer the application to the Inspection Committee for inspection and report. After receiving the report from the Inspection Committee, the Secretary, BCI shall place the file before the Legal Education Committee for its recommendation to the BCI for approval of the affiliated Centres of Legal Education or recognition of the degree in law of the University, as the case may be.

In the instant case of Ganjam Law College, the Bar Council of India has granted "approval of affiliation" for the session 2008-09 and 2009-10 vide Letter No. 1282 dated 23.09.2008. Subsequently, the BCI informed the Registrar, Berhampur University vide Letter No. 500 dated 23.5.2011 that after receipt of affiliation letter from the University, the "approval of affiliation" shall be considered for the session 2010-11. Later, the affiliation letter was issued by the University for the session 2010-11 vide letter No. 10974 dated 1.12.2011.

Affiliation process of the College from the session 2011-12 to 2014-15 was delayed due to correspondence with the BCI and delay in receipt of Government Recognition. The Government Recognition and University Affiliation were considered after receiving the judgement of the Hon'ble High Court of Orissa in WPC No. 666 of 2015 and 6259 of 2016. Presently, the College has been granted affiliation till 2014-15 and after issue of the affiliation letter, the College has applied to the Bar Council of India for "approval of affiliation" vide Letter No. 141 dated 31.5.2019 and No. 170 dated 19.6.2019 and awaiting for inspection.

The role of the State Bar Council is to enrol as Advocate only such candidates who have passed from University, approved affiliated Centre of Legal Education/ Departments of the recognised University. The enclosed enrolment certificates issued by the State Bar Council reveals that the students those who have passed from Ganjam Law College during the year 2014-2018 have been granted Registration of Advocacy.
