 - i) The Action Taken Report presented by the Director, IQAC was discussed and approved by the members.
 - ii) Steps be initiated to prepare the AQAR for the period 2020-21 and be submitted within the stipulated time.
 - The 3rd Cycle of NAAC accreditation process has been delayed due to the iii) pandemic, frequent lockdowns, and other institutional factors. Now, that the situation seems to be improving, the accreditation process be initiated.
 - iv) Steps be taken to prepare & submit the IIQA (Institutional Information for Quality Assessment) before 24th August 2021 along with the requisite fee.
 - Initiate preparation of the SSR (Self-Study Report) and keep it ready so that it can V) be submitted within 45 days of the approval of the IIQA.
 - vi) In order to encourage interdisciplinary research, it is proposed to introduce lecture series by the internal faculty members as well as Professors/Researchers/Domain experts from other organizations under a program called "Know Your Colleagues' Research (KYCR)".
 - As online classes have become a necessity due to different unforeseen situations, vii) the IT infrastructure and Internet connectivity to departments be strengthened, and provisions be made to subscribe to virtual platforms like Google Classroom/Cisco Webex/Zoom in order to facilitate blended mode of teaching.
 - viii) Steps be initiated to publish the BU Research Journal and BU Annual Magazine by September 2021.
 - Director, Innovation & Incubation Centre to give a progress report on its ix) activities, with regard to innovations and incubations, if any.
 - The existing road side solar lights in the campus be made functional. \mathbf{x})
 - xi) Solid waste and liquid waste management system to be improved.
 - Plantation activities to be undertaken during rainy season. xii)
 - Library automation work to be completed by September, 2021 xiii)
