Association of Indian Universities (AIU)

The Association of Indian Universities (AIU) is an apex inter-university representative body of universities and other higher education institutions in the country. Established in 1925 as the Inter-University Board (IUB) of India, it acquired its legal status as a registered society in 1967 under the Societies Registration Act 1860 and was rechristened as the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) in 1973. AIU is the second oldest university association in the world next to the Association of Commonwealth Universities which was established in 1913. It has the largest network of universities and other HEIs, with 958 members in India and 17 Associated members from foreign countries. The membership of AIU includes all types of universities e.g., conventional universities, open universities, deemed to be universities, state universities, central universities, private universities and institutes of national importance. Furthermore, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Republic of Kazakhstan, Malaysia, Mauritius, Nepal, Thailand, United Arab Emirates and the United Kingdom are its Associate Members. Since its inception AIU has played a very significant role in the development of higher education in the Country.

Some eminent scholars and visionary leaders like Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan, Dr Shyama Prasad Mukherjee, Dr Zakir Hussain, and Sir A L. Mudaliar have given leadership to AIU. During such a long journey, AIU has carved a niche for itself by serving the Ministry of Education, Govt of India as a research-based policy advisory body. Being an apex institution, it constitutes an integral part of all major decision-making committees and commissions in the country. As an academic 'think tank' organization, AIU supports the Government as a research-based policy advisory body with the wider mandate of taking up research projects on higher education policy and capacity building. It also acts as a bureau of information on higher education; liaises with international bodies and universities for the internationalization of Indian higher education among many others. Berhampur University

Berhampur University (BU) is a public-funded state university established on 2nd January 1967. The campus is known as Bhanja Bihar, named after the celebrated poet of Odisha Kabisamrat Upendra Bhanja. Spreading over an area of over 250 acres, the university is 12 kilometres and 5 kilometres away from the Berhampur City and Sea-beach (Bay of Bengal) of Gopalpur, respectively. There are 25 post-graduate departments on the university campus,

that offer specialized subjects and Ph.D./D.Sc. Programs. The University has 173 affiliated colleges with various subjects and disciplines such as Arts, Science, Commerce, Law, Education, Medicine, Pharmacology, Homoeopathy, Ayurveda, Nursing, Military Science, Library Science and Fine Arts.
