The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made between the Linguistics research Unit, ISI Kolkotta [here in after called 'LRU ISI'First party], on the ONE PART and the PG Department of Linguistics Berhampur University, Ganjam, Odisha [hereinafter called 'BU'/ Second party] on the OTHER PART.

WHEREAS The Linguistic Research Unit (LRU) was established by Professor Prasanta Chandra Mahalanabis, the Founder-Director of Indian Statistical Institute, in 1940's or even earlier. The main research activity of the Unit during that time was related to analysis of frequency of occurrence of words in vocabularies of prominent Bengali authors like Rabindranath Tagore, Bankimchandra Chattopadhyay, Saratchandra Chattopadhyaya and others. These studies were an innovation in Indian Linguistics and Professor Mahalanabis' plan to apply statistical technology to linguistic data analysis and interpretation was an extremely modern one, particularly in the Indian perspective. These works on the Bengali vocabulary had tremendous relevance in studies on linguistic usage in Bengali and also for linguistic as well as stylistic predictions. The objectives were three-fold: working towards a basic Bengali primer based on colloquial Bengali; preparing graded word list for use in textbooks for children in three different age groups, and studying vocabularies of representative authors from stylometric point of view. Validity / Termination:

The MoU shall be effective from the date of its signing by both the parties. It shall be valid for a period of five years. Thereafter it shall be automatically renewed for a period of five years unless either party serves notice on the other of its intention to terminate it. The Memorandum of Understanding shall stand terminated at the end of one calendar month from the date of issue of a notice of termination. But the termination of this Memorandum of Understanding shall not affect the validity or duration of specific collaboration programmers already being undertaken thereunder, unless decided otherwise by the parties by mutual consent.

This agreement shall take erect on the day it is signed and shall continue until agreement between the parties. Any terminated changes must be agreed to in writing by both parties. A minimum period of six months notice will be required from either to terminate the agreement.
