Prospectus for Ph.D. Programme for Working Professionals

Aim and Objective of the Programme

The Ph.D. Programme for Working Professionals offered under Berhampur University is targeted for the working professions having academic bent of mind and aims at offering opportunities to carry out investigation on socially significant, relevant and impactful research topics to build and develop indigenous innovative Technological, Social, Economic, and Business models on identified research problems. It also aims at developing high quality researchers and policymakers for Profit and Non-Profit Organizations, and Government Institutions/Departments. It would give scope to for carrying out researches in different areas and disciplines such as Pure Sciences, Humanities and Social Sciences, Commerce and Management and Pedagogical Sciences.

The key objective of this programme is to provide an opportunity to senior and middle-level professionals to advance their professional practices, research skills and subject expertise concerning Collaborative Research, Consultancy, Training, and Teaching by advancing their own holistic development and professional growth resulting in significant self-confidence and enhancement of social and intellectual status. It would further provide opportunity to enter into academics or continue in industry in the capacity of consultants, trainers and researchers. This will certainly provide career advancement through advanced degree and knowledge pertaining to senior level issues and problems.

The Programme is open for various groups of professionals from amongst:

Eligibility Criteria

- 1. A candidate for the Programme should have a minimum of five years of work experience in an organization of repute in the respective field.
- 2. A candidate for the Programme must have one of the following qualifications obtained from any of the universities incorporated by an Act of the Central or State Legislature in India or other educational institutions established by an Act of Parliament or Deemed to be the University under section 3 of UGC Act, 1956; or any discipline or allied discipline or a Post-Graduate qualification from recognized foreign universities or institutions.
 - A Master's degree in any discipline, with at least 55 percent aggregate marks or Equivalent Grade Point Average

OR

- A Post-Graduate Programme/Executive Post-Graduate Programme / Post Graduate Programme for Working Executives from IIMs/IITs and or an Equivalent Educational Qualification obtained from State/Central/ Deemed/Private Universities with Minimum Grade Point Equivalent to 6.0 out of 10-Point Scale.
- 3. The candidate should possess good moral character, certified by the Head of the Institution/Department last attended, to be enclosed along with the application for registration.
- 4. Candidates need to provide a 'NO OBJECTION' Certificate issued by the employing authority, stating that it has no objection if the candidate pursues the PhD Programme for Working Professions under Berhampur University for Entrepreneurs self declaration to be given with evidence.

QUALIFYING PhD ENTRANCE TEST FOR WORKING PROFESSIONALS

- The PhD Entrance Test will comprise of the Written Test conducted once a year, subject to availability of slots.
- The question papers of Entrance Test will be objective type in nature, in English language only.
- The Syllabus of the Entrance Test shall consist of 50% Research Methodology and 50% Subject Specific.
- After qualifying the Entrance Test by securing minimum of 50% of marks in the Entrance Test, candidate shall be required to discuss his or her research through PowerPoint Presentation of Research Proposal on an identified and chosen Research Topic/Research Problem which will be followed by Viva Voce to be conducted by the respective Departmental Research Committee.

The candidates who have qualified in UGC-CSIR/NET/SET/GATE/GPAT/DBT/ICMR/ JRF as well as M.Phil. Degree holders are exempted from appearing in the PhD Entrance Test for Working Professionals.

Applications for PhD Programme for Working Professionals

Eligible and interested working professionals can apply in the prescribed form downloading from the University Website <u>www.buodisha.edu.in</u>

The candidates enrolled under PhD Programme for Working Professionals shall be governed under the "Berhampur University Standards and Procedures for Award of Ph.D. Degree Regulations, 2020".

Selection of the Candidate

- a) Candidates who meet the above requirements should look out for prospective faculty members in the department where he/she is interested to register for his/her PhD degree.
- b) A research proposal approved by the prospective supervisor must be submitted by the candidate at the time of the application.
- c) The candidates fulfilling the above will have to appear for interview/test along with other regular candidates appearing for PhD admissions.

Requirement of Course Work, Examinations and Other Requirements

- a) The coursework curriculum for the PhD for Working Professionals will be the same that is meant for the regular Pre-PhD course work. However, the working professionals are exempted from attend the regular classes and can attend online classes on Sundays and Holidays.
- b) The working professionals may also attend online courses run through MOOCS, NPTEL/Virtual Classrooms/Interactive Exercises and Active Learning programs offered only by IIT/IISc/IIM/IISER.
- c) Self-study courses with standard format (weekly or bi-weekly assignments and sending them by email to the Head of the Department/Coordinator) will be mandatory to ensure progress and rigour.
- d) The candidate will have to appear for only the end semester examinations at the time of conduct of Examination for regular Pre-PhD Course Work students and should secure minimum 55% marks to be eligible for registering for Ph.D. programme.
- e) The course work examination will be of minimum 16 credit points.
- f) Submission of yearly progress report though presentation will be compulsory.
- g) The candidate shall have to spend at least 15 days per year at Berhampur University (in one or more spells) for interacting with his Supervisor that may include working in the Laboratory, etc.

h) During this period the candidate may stay at appropriate guest houses of the Institute on payment basis, subject to availability. If the student needs to spend extended period (beyond one month), Berhampur University will extend hostel, library, outdoor medical and other facilities on payment basis.

Duration of Ph.D. Program for Working Professionals

The minimum duration of PhD program for such candidates shall be of 3 years and the maximum of 7 years from the date of enrolment.

Synopsis and Thesis Submission

- a) In order to become eligible for the submission of the Thesis, the candidate must have at least two publications in UGC Care/Refereed Journals.
- a) Rest of the rules for synopsis, thesis submission/ viva-voce will be as per the existing rules of the University as mentioned above.
