**About the University**

The Maharaja Sriram Chandra Bhanja Deo University (formerly North Orissa University), accredited with 'A' Grade by NAAC, was established by the Government of Orissa, under Section 32 of the Odisha University Act, 1989 (Act 5 of 1989), vide notification No. 880 dated 13th July 1998. It was carved out of the Utkal University and became operational since 1999 at Takatpur (98.84 acres) of Baripada in the Mayurbhanj District of Odisha as an affiliating university. The University is recognized by the University Grants Commission under Sections 2(f) and 12(B) of UGC Act, 1956 with effect from 15th February 2000 and 21st June 2006, respectively. The territorial jurisdiction of the university extends over Mayurbhanj and Keonjhar districts of the northern part of Odisha, thickly populated with tribal communities. MSCBU's jurisdiction covers 110 colleges (Mayurbhanj-68 + Keonjhar-42) including 3 Autonomous Colleges, 2 Law Colleges, 1 Medical College, 3 Teachers' Education (B. Ed.) Colleges (including one for physically challenged) imparting education to a large number of students at the graduate and post-graduate levels. MSCBU is recognized by Bar Council of India, DEC, IGNOU, NCTE and included in the list of Association of Indian Universities and Association of Commonwealth Universities.

About the Department

The Department of Anthropology and Tribal Studies was established in 2001. From 2001-02 academic session started M.A. in Tribal Studies course on self financing mode. The M.A. in Tribal Studies renamed as M.A./M.Sc. in Anthropology and Tribal Studies from 2009-10 academic session. M.Phil and PhD in Anthropology and Tribal Studies introduced from 2010-11. The department has been regularized from academic session 2021-22 with five regular faculty members having specialization in socio-cultural, biological and archaeological anthropology. Presently the M.A./M.Sc course having 30 seats out of which 06 seats reserved for biological science graduates. Pre-Ph.D and Ph.D programmes has been introduced in 2022-23.
