About the University

The Maharaja Sriram Chandra Bhanja Deo University (Erstwhile North Orissa University) was established by the Government of Orissa, under the Section 32 of the Odisha University Act, 1989 (Act 5 of 1989), vide notification No. 880 dated 13th July 1998. It is located at Takatpur of Baripada in the Mayurbhanj District of Odisha. The University is recognized by the University Grants Commission under Sections 2(f) and 12(B) of UGC Act, 1956 with effect from 15th February 2000 and 21st June 2006, respectively. Baripada, the district headquarter of Mayurbhanj is 270 km away from Bhubaneswar, the State Capital of Odisha. It is one of the important tourist destinations in the northern part of Odisha. The climate is moderately warm and humid during summer but quite pleasant in winter. November to February is the best time of the year to visit Baripada. Strategically, Baripada has a unique location distinction of being situated in the lap of Similipal, the only Biosphere Reserve of the state of Odisha. The beautiful and historic places of tourist interest include Devkund, Sitakund, Khichakeswari Temple at Khiching. Baripada is situated 250 km away from Kolkata and 220 from Tata Nagar. The nearest railway station is Balasore and nearest airports are Kolkata and Bhubaneswar.
