The Similipal Biosphere Reserve (SBR) in the Indian State of Odisha is the sixth largest biosphere reserve in the country and forms a major part of the World Network of Biosphere Reserves. However, the reserve is currently under increasing pressure from a growing human population that directly depends on the reserve for their livelihoods.

Conference Objectives

The objective of the present conference is to develop a comprehensive understanding of the problems facing the SBR; and identify and analyze different factors that determine the extent of dependency of villages located in and around the reserve.
