### OFFICE ORDER

The Board of Paradip Port Authority (PPA) vide their Resolution No.205/2025-26 in the Meeting No.05/2025-26 held on 20.01.2026 have resolved to continue the existing productivity Norm for handling of Ammonium Nitrate (in bags) and Scrap with all existing terms and conditions.

- (1) Productivity Norm @ 2,500 MT per day for Ammonium Nitrate cargo vessels handled at CQ-1, CQ-2, SQ and MPB berths.
- (2) Productivity Norm @ 2,000 MT per day for Ammonium Nitrate cargo vessels handled at NQ2 and NQ3 berths.
- (3) Incentive Penalty Scheme shall not be levied for Ammonium Nitrate cargo vessels handled at CQ3 and NDC (Mooring berth).
- (4) Productivity Norm for scrap @ 3,000 MT per day for vessels handled at CQ-1, CQ-2, SQ, MPB, NQ2 and NQ3 .
- (5) The existing rate of incentive / penalty, method of calculation and other terms & conditions of Performance Norm based incentive / penalty will be made applicable.

This will be effective from 01.04.2026 till 30.09.2026 and shall be reviewed thereafter as and when required.
