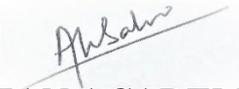

The students are required to adhere to the following guidelines while choosing Open Elective Subjects:

1. The Open Elective Subjects opted by the students must neither have been offered earlier in the programme nor have any similarity in the course content of any subject (**Core/Programme Elective Subjects/ 7th Semester Open Elective**) of the programme taught so far.

2. The students are required to choose their Open Elective subjects on or before **26.12.22. through Google form**, failing which they are bound to abide by the decision of Dean Academics on this matter.
3. The students may consult with their HOD, Mentor, Faculty advisor and give due consideration to the relevance and future prospects while choosing the open elective subject.
4. The Open Elective Subjects originating from a department cannot be opted by the students of that department.
5. If the number of students opting for a subject is less than 30, then that subject will not be offered as an open elective.
6. In each open elective subject, maximum 120 students will be allowed on the basis of CGPA and the order of preference submitted by the students.
7. The classes of Open Elective subjects may comprise of students of more than one branch.
8. Each student is required to submit their choices for maximum five (5) open elective subjects in order of their preferences.
