Some More Guidelines/Information:

- It is mandatory for a student of debarred category to enrol in the Summer Quarter Classes and Examinations-2019. Here <u>debarred category of students</u> means the students debarred in one or more theory subjects in the regular End (Odd and Even) Semester Examinations, 2018-19 and Summer Quarter Examinations, 2018. Any student who does not belong to the debarred category is referred to be a non-debarred category student. A student of non debarred category can register in Summer Quarter Examinations 2019 in each backlog subject and appear in the Examinations.
- One internal Examinations of Maximum 40 Marks and of duration 2hrs shall be conducted for each subject. The question shall be from the entire syllabus and there will be 40 objective type questions. A student shall be awarded a maximum of 16 marks in this exam. Any student who secured Failed grade in a subject and obtained less than 16 in the formative assessment component in any theory subject can appear in the test. Information on Internal marks may be obtained from the Examination Cell.
- For registration in the backlog Sessional, Laboratory subjects the students need to obtain
 permission from the Heads of the Department handling the subject. For registration in the
 backlog Mini/Major Project and General Proficiency a student needs to obtain permission
 from the HOD of the respective department if the student belongs to 2nd,3rd or 4th year of the
 programme and the Dean First Year if the student belongs to 1st year of the programme.
- The students of 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018 batches must note the following involving promotion to higher Semester.

For securing admission in Third Year (5th Semester B.Tech.), a student must successfully complete/pass in each Sessional/Laboratory/Seminar/Project subject and does not have backlogs in more than 3 theory papers of first year by the end of 2nd year.

For securing admission in Fourth Year (7th Semester B.Tech.), a student must successfully complete/pass in each subject of first year course, must successfully complete/pass in each Sessional/Laboratory/Seminar/Project/Viva subject of Second Year Course, and does not have backlogs in more than 3 theory papers of first year by the end of 3rd year.
